Summer Enrichment Programs Go Online

From June 22 to July 24, DCPS will provide virtual summer programming for students in grades K-12. Enrichment offerings for elementary and middle school students will focus on literacy, science, math, and social studies, while high school courses will focus on credit recovery, and there will be English Learner programming for students. Extended School Year (ESY) services will be available to eligible students. ESY services will include special education and related services outlined in the ESY section of eligible students' IEPs. Additionally, Career Ready Internships will continue in a virtual environment. More information will be posted at dcps.dc.gov/summer.

We also anticipate offering an in-person "summer bridge" program in August should health conditions allow. This option would be hosted at every DCPS school and available to all students in grades 3, 6, and 9, with a focus on an enrichment curriculum. More information on staff opportunities for the summer bridge program is forthcoming.

<u>Free grab-and-go meal service</u> will also continue at school locations citywide throughout the summer. Please note, however, student meals and grocery distribution will not take place this Monday on Memorial Day.

- Xfinity hotspots will now be open until June 30, 2020.
- Comcast Internet Essentials extended their application deadlines for 2 months of free internet and waiving of outstanding debt qualification to June 30, 2020.
- T-Mobile similarly extended benefits for customers through June 30, 2020:

- All current T-Mobile plans with data will be granted free unlimited data until June 30, 2020
- T-Mobile is working with its Lifeline partners to provide customers up to 5GB per month of extra free data through June 30, 2020
- T-Mobile is increasing the data allowance for free to schools and students using the <u>EmpowerED</u> program to ensure each participant has access to at least 20GB of data per month through June 30, 2020
