Term 4 Grades for K-5

Term 4 began on Monday, April 27 and will continue through the last day of school on Friday, May 29. A virtual Parent-Teacher Conference Day will take place on May 22, 2020 and there will be no learning at home on Monday, May 25, 2020 for the Memorial Day holiday. For term 4, elementary school students in Kindergarten to 5th Grade will receive a "P" (pass) in content areas where they were able to consistently engage (a minimum of 2 times per week) in learning at home assignments and activities. Students will be assigned a "NM" (no mark) in content areas where they were unable to engage in learning at home assignments and activities. Students in elementary school will not receive final grades.

During this period of school building closures due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we are reaching out to families to get an understanding of how learning at home is going for you and to receive feedback to help our teachers and staff continue to provide support.
